



BSc in Nautical Science Admissions Criteria

Applicants who wish to enroll to the BSc in Nautical Science program/CoC Officer in Charge of a Navigational Watch, must provide to the admissions office the following documents:

1. High School Leaving Certificate

- Must hold a High School Leaving Certificate or equivalent qualification with an average grade of 15 out of 20 or its equivalent
- A concentration in Mathematics and/or Physics is preferred. Applicants are required to possess a minimum of 75% in Mathematics or successfully pass a placement test in Mathematics.

In addition to a strong academic record, the applicant's involvement in extracurricular activities, leadership skills and other relevant background information will be considered.

2. English Language – EU and non-EU candidates

Cadets should present at least one of the following certificates:

- IELTS Certificate with a minimum score of “5.5”
- TOEFEL IBT with minimum a minimum score of “72”
- IB English B Standard Level (SL) with a minimum score “5”
- IB English B High Level (HL) with a minimum score “5”
- IB English A Literature SL & HL with a minimum score “5”
- Cambridge IGCSE or GCSE English as a First language with a minimum score “D”
- Cambridge GCE English A Levels with a minimum score “C”
- Cambridge GCE AS Level English Language with a minimum score “C”
- Anglia Examinations with a minimum level “Advanced”
- Password Skills Test Plus with a minimum score of “5.5”
- Michigan Language Assessment (ECCE) with a minimum score “53”
- SAT Evidence-Based Reading and Writing (EBRW) with a minimum score “530”

The Common European Framework of Reference (CEFR) for Languages is **B2**.

3. Interview with the Academy

Applicants who fulfill the admissions criteria must attend an interview with the Academy (in person or on-line). Successful applicants will receive a conditional acceptance bounded on the fulfillment of the requirements described below.



4. Further Requirements

Successful applicants must submit to the Academy the following Certificates in order to proceed with the issuing of an unconditional acceptance letter:

- Medical Fitness Certificate for Service at Sea (based on the Regulation STCW 1/9) from a doctor/medical center/ hospital approved by the Department of Merchant Shipping in Cyprus, or the relevant authority in your country of origin
- Valid Clear Criminal Record Certificate
- 2 recent Passport size Photos
- Copy of ID and Passport
